## **Transportation**

The city of East Point is accessible via public transportation (Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority-MARTA) and has a MARTA station in its downtown. It is also near the College Park and Ft. McPherson stations.

 MARTA allows for quick, easy and affordable travel from East Point to the Atlanta area including: the Airport, Midtown, Buckhead, Centennial Olympic Park and Peachtree Center.

East Point is located 4 miles from the busiest airport in the world, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

 The Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport offers nonstop service to 150 domestic and 95 international cities in 57 countries

Conveniently located at the intersection of major interstates I-85 and I-75, East Point is within 15 minutes of most top Atlanta attractions.
